Life C	ycle Stages:
1.	Egg: The life cycle of a frog begins with small eggs laid in water.
2.	<b>Tadpole:</b> When the eggs hatch, tadpoles with long tails are born. They live in the water and breathe through gills.
3.	<b>Metamorphosis:</b> Tadpoles go through metamorphosis, where they develop legs and lungs. Their tail gradually disappears.
4.	<b>Young Frog (Froglet):</b> The froglet can now live both in water and on land. It has fully developed legs and lungs.
5.	<b>Adult Frog:</b> The frog becomes an adult with strong legs for hopping and a sticky tongue to catch insects.
